Decades of the League's Impact and Achievements

Since its founding, the League - born out of the women's suffrage movement that secured the 19th Amendment, ensuring women the right to vote - has:

- ▶ **1920s** - Secured passage of the first federal maternal and infant health care program.
- ▶ **1930s** - Helped shape the Social Security Act and fought for Child Labor Laws.
- ▶ **1940s** - Built public support for the creation of the United Nations.
- ▶ **1950s** - Sponsored the "Freedom Agenda" a nation-wide program of community education and discussion about civil liberties
- ▶ **1960s** Fought against discrimination in education, employment and housing.
- ▶ **1970s** Sponsored televised Presidential debates; campaigned for the Equal Rights Amendment; build grassroots support for the Clean Water Act.
- ▶ **1980s** - Played a lead role in the push for fairer tax policies; worked to increase the availability of quality child care.
- ▶ **1990s** - Led the successful campaign for passage and implementation of the Motor Voter Law
- ▶ **2000s** - Offered the first "candidate debates" online through a nationwide, Internet based, voter education program - www.dnet.org; help pass major legislation on campaign finance reform and election administration reform; and continue to push for health care reform, finance reform and transparency in government.
